Drop-ins are considered to be an odd day when care is needed. The rate for drop-in care is as follows: \$5/hr for up to 7 hours for over age 2, or \$6/hr for up to 7 hours under age 2 \$35/day for 7+ hours for over age 2, or \$45/day for 7+ hours for under age 2

Clarke's Cubs determines the adult-to-child ratio based on the children's ages in our care and staff availability, so drop-in care may not always be available. Reservations for drop-in care will be accepted on a first-requested, first-served basis. Payment is due at the time your child is dropped off. Clarke's Cubs must have an up-to-date playspace waiver and drop-in contract for every child. Completed forms are required before care is provided.
